

David will provide an all-day demonstration at the Bridges Church in Los Altos. The doors will open at 9:00 am. The general public is invited to attend. Mark your calendars and don't miss this rare opportunity to spend the day with David Ellsworth, often referred to as the "Father of Modern Woodturning". David is unequalled in the turning world, but most turners already know this. David is most famous for his thin walled hollow forms turned thru a small opening, usually from spalted woods or with natural voids. His development of tools and techniques for thin wall "blind" hollowing revolutionized woodturning, and contributed greatly to the explosive growth of woodturning in the 1980's and 1990's. He is a founding member of the American Association of Woodturners (AAW) and served as its first President, nurturing and guiding it thru its early years. Without David's early commitment and unending support it is doubtful that the AAW would be the organization it is today! A heartfelt thanks from all of us, David!!

David's first book "Ellsworth on Woodturning" continues to receive rave reviews from the woodturning community.
