The West Bay Area Woodturners Society is pleased to announce a demonstration by professional turner Mike Mahoney on October 17 in Los Altos. Mike will provide an all-day demonstration at the Los Altos Multi-Purpose Room at 97 Hillview Ave. The doors will open at 8:30 am. The general public is invited to attend.

Mike Mahoney has been a professional turner since 1994. His early days involved production turning of salad bowls, but he is currently reducing his focus on production in favor of technical work. He is well known for his nested cored bowls, but he also makes platters, canisters, hollow forms, and funeral urns. His work is featured in galleries across the United States, and is sought after by collectors all over the world. His demonstration will cover hollow forms, urns, and bowls. He will also show you how to chase threads, and his special grind for bowl gouges.

Directions: take I-280 to El Monte Road exit, turn right on El Monte Road. Turn left on Foothill Expressway, then right on San Antonio Road. Just under ½ mile down on the right is the Hillview Ave. Turn right on Hillview Ave. and the Los Altos Multi-Purpose Room is 0.1 miles down on your left.

From Hwy 101, take the San Antonio Ave. exit South, go 3.7 miles on San Antonio Ave., turn left on Hillview Ave, and the Los Altos Multi-Purpose Room is 0.1 miles down on your left.
