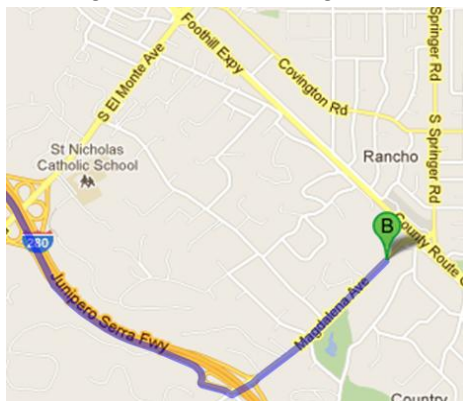

Directions: Take Hwy 280 South to Los Altos, take the Magdalena Ave. exit East. Go just under one mile. Bridges Church is on the left, just before the intersection with Foothill Expressway.

From the East Bay, take Hwy 237 West towards Mountain View. At the end of Hwy 237, continue across El Camino onto Grant Rd. Go 0.5 miles, turn right on Cuesta Drive. Go 1 mile, turn left on Springer Rd. Go about 1 mile, go slightly right to stay on Springer. Cross Foothill Expressway and continue onto Magdalena Ave. Bridges Church is 0.1 miles down on the right.
